- -All set 1 students in years 7-10 do basic skills every week. This includes one career based focus every week, for example finding information in a more complex or basic job description.
- -All reading of novels includes careers discussions, including Gansta Granny.
- -Employability skills such as communication, team building and listening are developed and used continuously in music.
- Guess speakers come on each RE day (once per term), they talk about how their faith has influenced their career path, for example a Buddhist may wish to look at the ethics of an industry to make sure no harm is done to animals or others.
- -Visit to places of worship are also visit to places of work
- During each unit of work and project students respond to a range of different artists.
